

LIQUOR LAWS

- Drinking Age is 21 ID is required at all bars and restaurants serving alcohol
- DWI Laws are STRICTLY ENFORCED
- No open containers are allowed outside (no street drinking allowed)
- No beverages can be brought into or taken out of a bar
- ALL Bars must cease alcohol sales at 2 am; All drinks must be cleared by 2:10am
- Liquor stores (which also sell Beer & Wine) must close at 9 pm
- No retail liquor sales on Sundays (All liquor stores are closed; bars ARE open)
- Liquor is NOT available at grocery stores (which do sell Beer & Wine)
- Beer/Wine cannot be sold at grocery stores before 12 Noon on Sundays
- Beer/Wine sales at grocery stores stop at midnight (1 am on Saturday)

AUSTIN FACTS

- Nickname: City of the Violet Crown (refers to our sunsets)
- ◆ Slogan: "The Live Music Capital of the World"
- Sales Tax: 8.25%
- SMOKE-FREE: Smoking is prohibited in all workplaces and public places, including restaurants, bars and indoor music venues.
- Numbered streets generally run East/West, parallel to Lady Bird Lake, start with 1st (also known as Cesar Chavez St) and go up as they go North
- We are **Austinites** (not Austinians or Austonians).
- Mount Bonnell is the city's highest point at 780 feet above sea level.
- It usually doesn't rain much. It's almost always warm, often hot.
- Austin is home to **more than 114,000 students**. Demographically the city is generally more educated, younger (median age is 30), more politically active and more liberal than the rest of Texas.
- The City of Austin's population has grown by 96% since 1990.

AUSTIN ATTRACTIONS

- Barton Springs Pool is a 3-acre naturally spring-fed swimming pool with an average water temperature of 68 degrees. Located downtown in Zilker Park, on the South side of Lady Bird Lake, it is usually open year-round.
- Zilker Park & Botanical Garden is a 31-acre downtown jewel with themed gardens, a butterfly trail and prehistoric villages.
- The Texas State Capitol is the largest capitol building in the US.
- The Lady Bird Lake Hike & Bike Trail is 10.1 miles of urban beauty
- ◆ The Lyndon B. Johnson Presidential Library contains a 7/8 scale version of the Oval Office. Admission is \$8, less for seniors and children
- The historic 6th Street Entertainment District is renowned for its density of live music venues, bars, pubs, clubs and restaurants.
- ◆ The world's Largest Urban Bat Colony lives under the Ann Richards Bridge
- Antone's Blues Club (5th St) launched the career of Stevie Ray Vaughn and has hosted some of the finest rock and blues musicians in the world.
- The Continental Club is a classic South Austin music venue
- Esther's Follies has been performing live, topical sketch & musical comedy, plus amazing stage magic on 6th Street for 24 hilarious years.
- ◆ Austin Museum of Art/arthouse, Harry Ransom Center, Blanton Museum and Texas State History Museum are among the **area's top museums**.
- The University of Texas Tower stands 27 stories above the campus and offers great views of the city,


